
# **IMPORTANT: READ ALL** INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS—This manual contains important instructions. They need to be followed during operation of this product.

#### Features



1	High volume/low pressure air hose: Inflates rafts, air mattresses and water toys.	
2	High pressure air hose: Inflates vehicle/bicycle tires and sporting equipment.	
3	Built-in storage for included inflation tips	
4	High volume "+/-" ports connect to the high volume air hose for quick inflation or deflation	
5	LED worklight

6	Analog (dial) air pressure gauge: On analog model compressors only. Needle and dial gauge displays the current air output of the compressor during use.	

8	Auto-Fill setting buttons: (High pressure application on digital model only) Allow users to select and save their desired air pressure; compressor automatically shuts off when the proper pressure has been reached.	
9	High Pressure On/Off button: Turns the compressor unit on and off for high pressure applications	
10	High Volume On/Off button: Turns the compressor unit on and off for high volume applications.	
11	LED Light button: Turns the LED worklight on and off.	
12	<b>12V input connector:</b> (Stored in bottom of unit) Plugs into your car's 12V accessory power outlet to run the compressor	

13 Additional inflation tips: Adapters allow for inflating sport balls and other small inflatable items.

### **Before you start**

# WARNING: Risk of injury

The compressor may become hot during use. Do not hold in hand while operating Place compressor on a hard, clean surface.

# WARNING: Risk of injury or loss of life

Do not use this compressor on a running vehicle. Please make sure that the emergency brake is set and that the car is in "park". You may need to turn your ignition to "accessory" or "on" position (do not put vehicle in "drive") in order to power the compressor.

#### **Safety Precautions**

- 1. Please make sure the air hose chuck touches the core of the tire's valve stem for proper inflation.
- Do not use the compressor continuously for more than 30 minutes. Please allow the unit to cool for approximately 10 minutes in between uses. Do not allow the compressor to run while unattended.
   Always use a pressure gauge to check your tire pressure. Do not over-inflate your tire.
- Soft inflatables (i.e. rafts, sports equipment, etc.) may not have recommended pressure markings. Be careful not to over-inflate these items beyond their capacity.
- Never block the compressor input or output during use.
- Keep the compressor out of the reach of children.
- 7. Only use this compressor with 12 Volt DC power outlet

# Operation

# **High Pressure Applications: Inflating Tires**

# CAUTION: Risk of incomplete inflation

If your tire is totally deflated, it is possible that the tire could separate from the rim, allowing air to leak out when trying to inflate. In the event that this occurs, it may be necessary to jack up the tire prior to inflation.

- 1. Screw the high pressure air hose connector onto the tire's valve stem.
- Plug the power cord into the 12 Volt accessory power outlet (see Safety Precautions above).
   Press the high pressure on/off button to turn on the compressor. Inflate the tire to manufact

Press the high pressure on/off button to turn on the compressor. Inflate the tire to manufacturer's recommended air pressure.

Current pressure level

- 1. Set your desired compressor auto inflation level by pressing up/down push buttons. You will see the desired pressure level increase/decrease in the number above the "set" icon.
- 2. Once you have set the desired pressure (PSI) level, release the buttons. The desired level is displayed above the "set" icon on the screen.
- 3. The desired pressure level will automatically be stored after 2 seconds once the button(s) have been released
- 4. Press the tire icon to start the compressor. The compressor will fill the tire (or other inflatable) to the desired PSI and then shut off. During operation, the current pressure level on the display will gradually increase until the desired pressure level has been reached.

# Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
Compressor doesn't turn on	<ol> <li>The fuse, located in the plug adapter, may have blown. Unscrew the Philips screw of the plug adapter, remove fuse and inspect. If necessary, replace the fuse with one of the same size and amperage.</li> <li>Check the vehicle power outlet fuse; it should be a minimum of 15 amps.</li> <li>Check receptacle and plug terminals for dirt (particularly tobacco). Use a non-conductive probe (NOT fingers or metal!) to dislodge and remove debris.</li> <li>Push the power plug firmly into the receptacle and twist it back and forth.</li> </ol>
Compressor runs but does not inflate	<ol> <li>Be sure that the air hose connector is tightly screwed onto the valve stem.</li> <li>Check tire for leaks. Check hose for breaks and leaks at fittings.</li> </ol>
Compressor runs slowly	<ol> <li>The compressor may have overheated from excessive use. Shut it off and allow it to cool for 10 minutes.</li> <li>The voltage may be too low. Check the condition of your vehicle's battery.</li> </ol>

- 4. When proper pressure is reached, press the on/off button again to turn off the inflator.
- 5. Unplug the power cord and remove the air hose connector from your tire.

Note: Correct tire pressure can be found in your vehicle's owner's manual or on the driver's side door jamb.

# High Volume/Low Pressure Applications: Inflating Additional Items (rafts, mattresses, water toys).

- 1. Attach the proper inflation adapter to the compressor's high volume/low pressure air hose.
- 2. Connect the high volume air hose to the "+" port on the side of the compressor to add air, or to the "-" port to remove air.
- 3. Insert the hose end with adapter into the inflatable's air inlet.
- 4. Plug the power cord into the 12 Volt accessory power outlet (see Safety Precautions above).
- 5. Press the **high volume** on/off button to turn on the compressor.



- 6. Carefully inflate to your desired level. Go slowly and be cautious not to over-fill the inflatable item.
- 7. Unplug the power cord and remove the air hose.
